Reception & Nursery Why do you love me so much?



Encourages children's curiosity, understanding, knowledge and imagination about themselves and their relationships with others

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Year 1 Memory Box



Can you remember being small? Being a baby and learning to crawl? Do you recall a favourite toy, maybe a teddy bear or a best loved book

Learn how to write a diary of days gone by, and find out about days before you were born: it's called history and it's all about the past.

Look back at family photos of special occasions, perhaps birthday or christening photos.

Memories are special...Let's make more!

Year 2 Muck, Mess, Mixtures



Let's get messy! Muck and mess is good! In fact, it's mega-marvellous!

Pour, mix, stir and splat! How does it feel to get your hands covered in goo? Make a wobbly jelly and draw with wobbly clay.

Write recipes, instructions, riddles and poems- there are loads of scrummy words to describe messy mixtures!

Work with pain and other squelchy stuff to create a new gallery space. What will you make? How will you arrange it? How will the gallery make you and visitors feel?

Year 3 Predator



It's time to take a walk on the wild side! Find out who's coming to visit...is it a bug-munching lizard or an eagle-eyed bird of prey? Whatever it is, do you think you can handle it?

Learn about creepy craws and amazing alligators, the deadly assassin bug and the voracious Venus flytrap. Be inspired to write a leaflet all about your favourite predator and compose a poem about a predator or its prey.

The children will use what you know to create the ultimate predator; the apex of the chain. Cross your dad with a peregrine falcon or your gran and with a white shark- what incredible species can you imagine?

Year 4 Blue Abyss



Grab your wetsuit! We're going deep into an underwater world of incredible coral and mysterious sea creatures.

What do real divers get up to below the surface? Create a fishy story about exploring an amazing underwater world.

Flippers on? Snorkel ready? Let's head into the abyss...

Year 5 Time Traveller



Tick...Tock...Tick...Tock...The hands on the clock never stop from the moment we are born, from toddler to teen, middle age to elderly, time stops for no man. The children will be finding out what happens to our bodies and brains as they grow older and how people grow with these changes. They will find out how long it takes a human baby to grow in the womb and how long it takes an elephant calf or a kitten. 'Tom's Midnight Garden' will inspire their writing and the children will be trying to imagine what it might be like to travel in time - to the past or to the future.

Year 6 Fallen Fields/ A Child's War



A siren sounds, a building crumbles, a Spitfire zooms overhead. Take cover! It's 1939 and Britain is at war. Deep down in the Anderson shelter, learn why nations are fighting and why child evacuees must make the long journey from their home and families into unknown territory.

Read Anne Frank diary, written whilst hiding from the terrifying storm-troopers in a secret annexe, and try to empathise with her hope and dreams
